Successful Drug Prevention and First Step Workshops in the Philippines and China

Based on escalating statistics of drug abuse in the Philippines, especially a methamphetamine epidemic, newly elected Philippines President, Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, has launched an all-out anti-drug campaign. To research for better resources, the Director of the PDEA (Philippines Drug Enforcement Agency) and his entourage traveled to Los Angeles and met with the President of Narconon International. He requested that Narconon come to the Philippines to deliver workshops on drug education and Narconon drug-free withdrawal.

On July 26th 2003, the Narconon International team composed of Clark Carr (President), Bobby Wiggins (Consultant and Drug Educator), Dr. Nerida James (President Narconon Australia), and Carolyn Judd (Narconon volunteer), flew to Manila and delivered a week of very successful workshops.

Bobby and Clark conducted the Drug Education Workshop. The workshop attendees--48 in total--were made up of PDEA employees, directors from drug rehabilitation centers, and drug rehabilitation counselors. They covered the basics about drugs, gave them practical experience with Mr. Hubbard's technology of study, and

drilled them on the use of the emotional tone scale and group localions. The group really enjoyed doing communication drills. On the third day, 22 of these newly trained educators went to a school and made drug education presentations in 19 classrooms simultaneously. A total of 1,040 students received drug education all in the same hour! The drug education lectures were a

howling success. After hearing the talks, many children stated they would no longer use drugs. The trainees, many of whom were police who carry out raids to shut down methamphetamine labs, were proud to receive their certificates as drug *educators*

and promised to continue to lecture to children throughout their country.

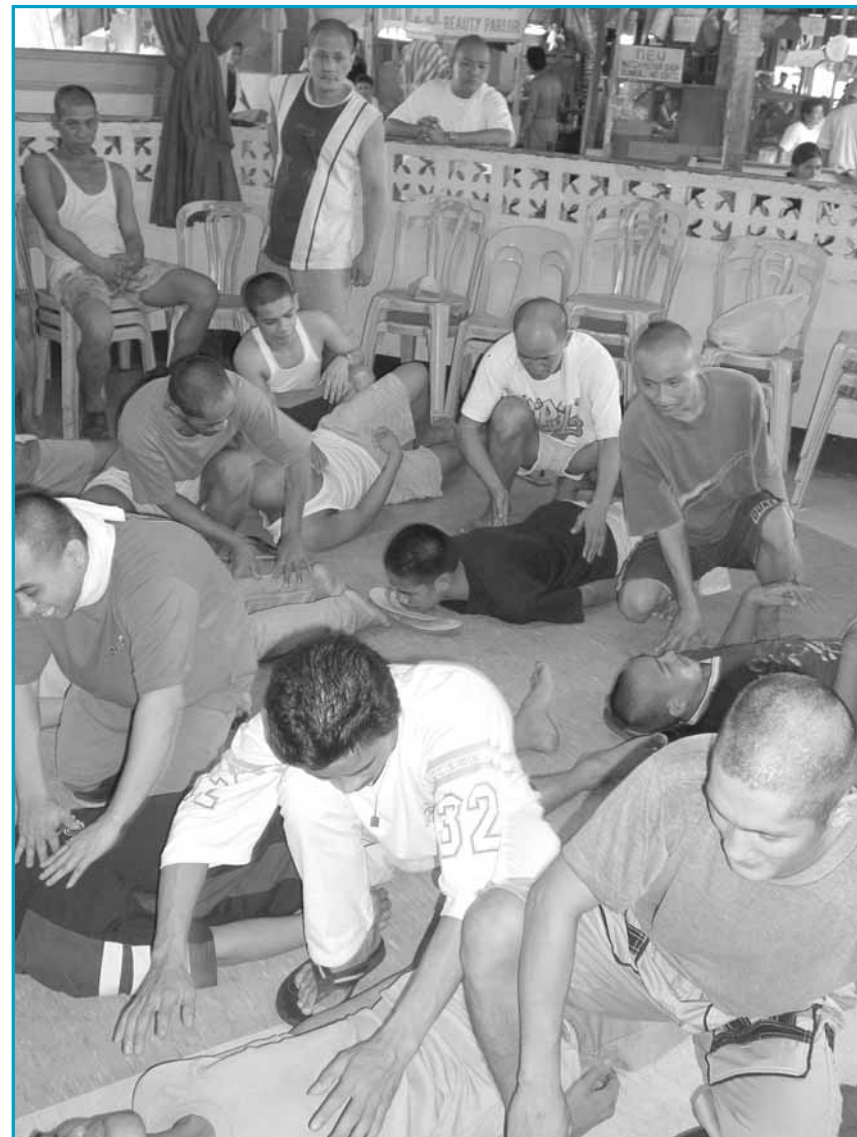
Clark and Dr. Nerida James also delivered the Narconon First Step drug-free withdrawal workshop to professionals from existing drug rehabilitation centers from across the Philippines. The Narconon team, along with the 36 trainees from the First Step workshop, went to Bikutan, the largest of the government-funded rehab facilities (3,000 addicts!). Fifty tables were set up in a large room so that some 400 adult addicts could be taught how to give each other assists and localions.

Later Clark, Bobby and Carolyn visited 300 children in the huge center - street orphans addicted to glue - and taught them, too, how to help each other with assists.

The team visited Quezon City Jail. Built to house 600 people, the current population is 2800 prisoners. They delivered a drug education lecture and instructed some 100 prisoners on how to do assists and localions.

a Narconon drug education center in Shanghai. WHO Shanghai definitely wants Narconon International to come twice a year to do further drug education and training.

A visit to the only private rehab center in Shanghai region (Huashi Recovery Center) resulted in their interest in adopting the full Narconon program. Knowing the value of demonstration, Clark delivered a nerve assist to an addict in the center; thereupon, another addict in the same room asked for one. The nurses who had been observing then spontaneously started giving assists to each

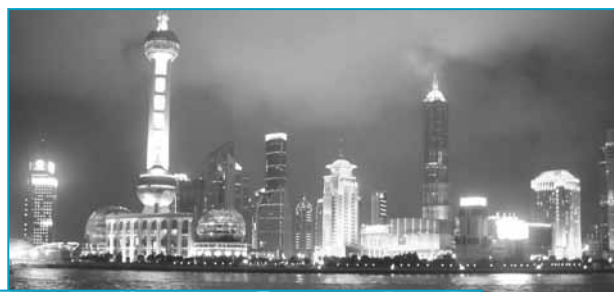


Chinese teacher practicing locational technology

After having introduced Narconon at a September 2002 symposium, Mr. Carr was invited by the WHO (World Health Organization) Shanghai Collaborating Center to return to Shanghai to further demonstrate Narconon methodology.

This trip included the first Narconon drug educator teacher training to 53 teachers and school administrators. Clark instructed them on the basics needed for delivering drug education in the schools. The following day, he gave the first drug education lecture to a 10th grade class. This training resulted in a demand to create

other! Dr. Dai, Director of the rehab, plans to come to Los Angeles in the fall to visit our local Narconon centers.

Clark also met with the executives of the Shanghai Jing An Hospital mega complex and gave them data on how to train staff to deliver L. Ron Hubbard's sauna detox program. Dr. Wu Xui Yong, Senior Administrator, is asking us to work in collaboration with the hospital to install and do the first pilot of the sauna detoxification in China.

Idaho Narconon Idaho is celebrating its grand opening on the 26th of September. This out-patient center is located in Burley, Idaho and has the capacity to service 30 students.

Arrowhead (1) Two years have passed since the move from Chilocco! Narconon Arrowhead is celebrating its second anniversary on the 20th of September in conjunction with National Recovery month. They continue to reach out broadly. In just the last six months they have reached over 13 million people through press articles in 47 states covering subjects ranging from ecstasy and methamphetamine abuse to solutions for preventing drug use.

Denmark The printing of the 10 Things Your Friends May Not Know About Drugs booklet in Danish is now complete. This booklet will be a great addition to their drug education program. These booklets are now available in nine languages!

Jordan (3) In 2002, the President of Narconon International visited Amman, Jordan, meeting with many officials. Interest was created in adopting the Narconon program for the rehabilitation of addicts. Recently, three of these officials came to Los Angeles to learn more about the program. Atlanta, Georgia (4) Narconon Georgia has been collaborating with the director of a local community group who sponsored a nine-week summer enrichment program for 45 kids ages 6 to 17. These kids studied the Learning How to Learn book by L. Ron Hubbard, along with other subjects such as math and science; they also received drug prevention presentations. Even though the kids are now back in school, they continue to return for more of the same program (now available after school), especially to review the study data so they can better apply it.

Stone Hawk (2) With many graduates and over 50 students currently, expansion is the word. Their facility only opened in January of this year, yet they are already in the process of opening a second center, White Buffalo, which will accommodate 40 students. Mexico Recently, the annual mayoral conference was held in Cancun, Mexico. While there, over 500 Mayors and their aides learned what the Narconon technology has achieved. Narconon Mexico also gave a drug education lecture to 250 police officers.



Moscow Narconon Standard, located 60 miles out of Moscow, just purchased a new building for their delivery. When the renovations are completed, the facility will house more than double the current number of students.

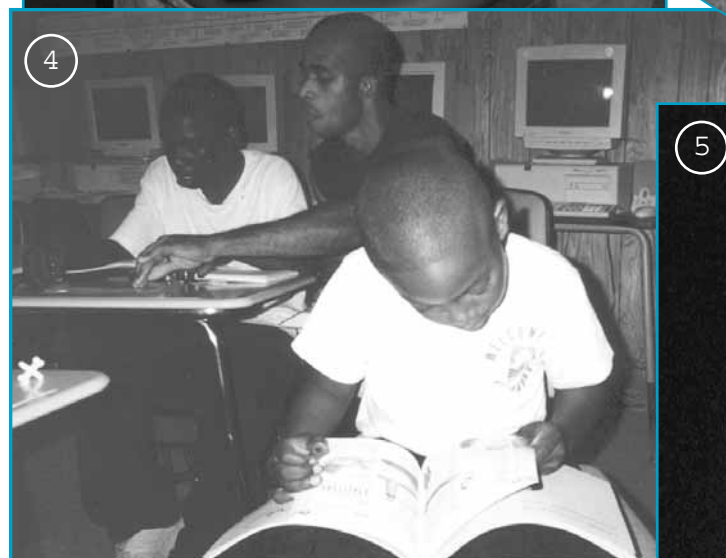
Spain Narconon Spain is now receiving referrals from the Anti-Drug Agency of Madrid, the senior government agency over the field of rehabilitation.

Krasnoyarsk, Russia The center is becoming a stable influence regarding rehabilitation matters. Recently, the Chief of Police gave them a full list of all the addicts in the region. Additionally, the post office distributed 220,000 Narconon flyers at no charge.

Pakistan (7) Narconon Hyderabad has been delivering the Narconon First Step program and drug education lectures. Dr. Sharif, Executive Director, decided to open a full rehab center and is now training at Narconon Huddinge in Sweden. Johannesburg (6) The six police officers (with 50 more to come) who recently trained as drug prevention lecturers have
